ENLISTMENT OF SUPPLY TEACHER (GENERAL PURPOSE) TO TEACH IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Applications are invited from:

- (a) retired Public Officers, who previously held one of the posts mentioned below:
- Deputy Headmaster; and
 - Primary School Educator
- and

(b) suitably qualified candidates outside the service

who wish to be considered for enlistment as Supply Teacher (General Purpose) in Primary Schools during the academic year 2021/2022.

2. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should not have reached their 65th birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

3. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should possess:-

- (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics obtained at not more than two sittings or
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level".

OR

Equivalent acceptable qualifications to A and B above.

C. Candidates should be computer literate.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

NOTE

- Candidates should provide written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
- The Ministry reserves the right to convene only the best qualified candidates for interview.

4. CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT AND REMUNERATION

- The enlistment will be purely on a temporary basis, as and when required, and may be

terminated at any time. Selected candidates will not have any claim for permanent appointment.

- Candidates will be paid fees at the rate of Rs 18650 monthly on a pro-rata basis, on days on which they actually work.
 - Bus fares will be refunded on the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates.
- Training:** Selected candidates from outside the service will be required to follow a two weeks crash course training at the Mauritius Institute of Education prior to being posted to Government Primary Schools.
